Summary

A Small Support A Big Difference

Education can transform a child's future, but for families living with financial constraints, even basic school requirements can become a challenge.

Neev95 Trust's **Stationery Donation Drive (SDD)** was initiated to address this simple yet significant barrier by providing essential educational materials to children studying in under-resourced schools.

The 2026–27 edition of the initiative was launched on **19 March 2026** and reached **2,600 students across 76 schools in Wada and Bhiwandi talukas of Maharashtra**.



Each student received an essential stationery kit, providing them with the basic learning materials needed to begin the academic year **prepared, confident and ready to learn**.

The initiative was made possible through the generous support of our CSR partner, individual donors, volunteers, school authorities and the Neev95 Trust team.

The project involved school identification, requirement assessment, fundraising, centralised procurement, grade-wise kit preparation and last-mile distribution.

Distribution was undertaken through dedicated teams covering schools across Wada and Bhiwandi. The Bhiwandi distribution was completed on **11 July 2026**, followed by the Wada distribution on **18 July 2026**.

The growth of SDD over the years has been encouraging. From supporting **346 students across 4 schools in 2023**, the initiative has expanded to reach **2,600 students across 76 schools in 2026**.

Beyond the numbers, the project seeks to create a meaningful difference in the everyday educational experience of children. A stationery kit may be a small intervention, but for a child and family facing financial hardship, it represents support, encouragement and the assurance that they are not alone in their educational journey.

The Stationery Donation Drive is therefore not simply about distributing stationery.

It is about removing one small barrier between a child and education.

Neev95 Trust is grateful to every partner and donor who has helped make this possible.

Objectives of the Project

The key objectives of the Stationery Donation Drive 2026–27 were to:

1. **Provide essential educational supplies** to students from economically disadvantaged families.
 2. **Reduce the financial burden** on families towards school-related expenses.
 3. **Support regular participation in school** by ensuring students have the basic materials required for learning.
 4. **Promote dignity and confidence** among children by equipping them for the academic year.
 5. **Strengthen access to education** for children studying in under-resourced schools.
 6. Encourage individuals, donors and organizations to contribute towards **sustainable educational support**.

Project Implementation

The 2026–27 Stationery Donation Drive was launched on **19 March 2026**, coinciding with Gudi Padwa.

The project involved multiple stages:

Phase 1 – Planning & School Identification

Schools in the Wada and Bhiwandi regions were identified based on need and previous engagement with the Trust. The requirement of stationery and the number of students to be supported were assessed in coordination with the schools.

Phase 2 – Fundraising

Neev95 Trust reached out to individual donors, supporters and corporate partners to raise funds for the initiative. The contribution required for one student was **₹750**, covering the stationery kit and logistics.

Phase 3 – Procurement

The stationery materials were procured centrally to ensure consistency in the contents and quality of the kits. The kits were organised grade-wise to facilitate efficient distribution across the participating schools.

Phase 4 – Distribution

The distribution was carried out through dedicated teams and vehicles to reach schools across the two talukas. The distribution was completed in July 2026.



Geographic Reach & Impact

The 2026 drive covered **76 schools across Wada and Bhiwandi talukas**, reaching a total of **2,600 students**.

Bhiwandi - 38 schools | 1,164 students

The Bhiwandi distribution was completed on **11 July 2026**, covering 38 Zilla Parishad schools as part of the distribution route.

Wada - 38 schools | 1,436 students

The Wada distribution was completed on **18 July 2026**, reaching 38 schools across the region.

Overall Reach - 76 Schools | 2,600 Students

The initiative enabled children across geographically dispersed and under-resourced communities to receive essential educational supplies for the academic year.

The Journey of the 2026 Drive

The successful implementation of SDD 2026 was made possible through the collective efforts of donors, CSR partners, volunteers, school authorities, vendors and the Neev95 Trust team.

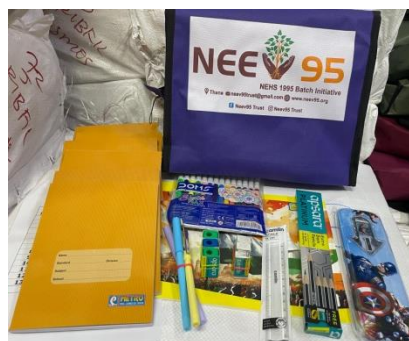
From fundraising and procurement to packing, transportation and last-mile distribution, every stage required careful coordination.

On distribution days, dedicated teams travelled early in the morning to reach schools located across Wada and Bhiwandi.

The logistics involved:

- **6 distribution teams**
- **6 cars**
- **6 tempos**
- Multiple school locations across two talukas
- Early-morning travel to ensure timely school deliveries

The distribution was not simply a logistical exercise. At every school, the arrival of the stationery kits brought excitement and enthusiasm among the children.



Impact on Children

The Stationery Donation Drive creates an immediate and tangible impact in the lives of children.

For the children supported through SDD 2026, the initiative helped ensure that they began the academic year with essential learning materials in hand.

The impact extends beyond the physical stationery:

Reduced Financial Burden

Families facing financial constraints are able to redirect limited household resources towards other essential needs.

Improved Preparedness

Students have the basic materials required to participate in classroom learning and activities.

Increased Confidence

Having their own school supplies helps children feel prepared, included and confident.

Encouragement to Continue Education

Small interventions that make schooling more manageable can contribute towards keeping children engaged with their education.

Monitoring & Accountability

Neev95 Trust follows a structured process for implementing the Stationery Donation Drive.

The project included:

- Identification of beneficiary schools
- Verification of student requirements
- Consolidation of school-wise beneficiary numbers
- Centralised procurement
- Grade-wise kit preparation
- School-wise distribution planning
- Distribution through dedicated teams
- Documentation of the distribution process



The Trust maintains relevant project and financial records to support transparency and accountability to its donors and partners.

Our Impact Journey

The Stationery Donation Drive has grown significantly since its inception.

From supporting **346 children across 4 schools in 2023** to reaching **2,600 children across 76 schools in 2026**, the growth of the initiative reflects the increasing support of our donor and volunteer community.
